- C1 - FOAL CHAMPIONSHIP** - All first placed foals
- C2 - MILLCROFT GELDING CHAMPIONSHIP** - All first placed **PURE BRED** geldings
- C3 - VETERAN CHAMPIONSHIP** -All veteran entries to come forward for judging
- C4 - OVERALL YOUNGSTOCK CHAMPIONSHIP** Youngstock champions and reserves

C5 - SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIP

All outright welsh section champions (not including Foal, Gelding, Veteran and Youngstock champions)

£50 to Champion £25 to Reserve Champion

The following class is a qualifier for the Supreme In-Hand qualifier at Stoneleigh Horse Show, 3rd-5th September 2021. The Supreme In-Hand Qualifier held at Stoneleigh Horse Show will offer two qualifying places for Horse of the Year Show, NEC, 6th-10th October 2021. The objective of the competition is to find the supreme light horse or pony in-hand champion of the year, irrespective of breed or type (excluding heavy horses).

The Champion horse or pony from the following classes will be eligible to compete in the Supreme In-Hand Semi Final, provided it has not already won a Supreme In-Hand qualifier in 2021.

• ***C2 Supreme Welsh In Hand Championship***

If the Champion has already qualified for Horse of the Year Show 2021 or is ineligible, then the Reserve Champion may come forward to Stoneleigh, provided it has not already qualified and is eligible. If both Champion and Reserve Champion have already qualified for Horse of the Year Show 2021 or are ineligible then the Semi-Final will not be represented at Stoneleigh. Foal champions and geldings four years old and over are not eligible to compete or eligible to qualify for Horse of the Year Show.

In the event of a horse/pony having been awarded more than one section Championship at this show, that horse/pony will represent both/all sections and the Semi Final qualification will not pass down to the Reserve Champion in the 2nd and any subsequent sections.

All classes are open to Yearlings, 2 year olds, 3 year olds, Stallions, broodmares and barren mares only. Broodmares must be with foal at foot or a relevant certificate of pregnancy. Mares which have not yet foaled or that have lost their foals are eligible to enter with a relevant certificate of pregnancy for the following year.

There will be no direct entry into Supreme In-Hand Championship Semi Final, all animals must be a supreme champion or reserve supreme champion.

Judges need not be registered on any society Judge's panel but must possess sufficient experience to judge.

NWAWPCS In-hand Rules

- 1 All exhibits MUST be registered with the Welsh Pony & Cob Society
- 2 No telephone or email entries will be accepted
- 3 All entries must be paid before the animal will be allowed to enter the ring
- 4 Animals and property will be considered as being in the exhibitors charge
- 5 All colts and stallions 2 years and over must be suitably bitted and let by a handler who has attained their 14th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.
- 6 Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times and children must be supervised.
- 7 The Committee will not be responsible for loss, damage or injury owing to accident or other cause
- 8 The Committee reserves the right to postpone, alter, cancel, devise or combine without notice, any or all events
- 9 Any objections must be lodged in writing with the secretary within 30 minutes of the class accompanied by a deposit of £25, which shall be forfeit if the objection is over-ruled
- 10 Any exhibit considered not to be under adequate control will be asked to leave the ring
- 11 It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that they enter the ring at the correct time. **NO** refunds will be given to exhibitors who miss their class
- 12 Classes will not be held up for exhibitors showing in more than one section
- 13 No class prize money will be given
- 14 **The judge's decision is final**

WPCS Ridden Rules

- 1 All exhibits MUST be registered with the Welsh Pony & Cob Society
- 2 Exhibitors may not win more than one medal on the day of the show
- 3 Spurs may not be worn in any class
- 4 Show canes/whips must not exceed 75cm. In lead rein classes only plain or leather covered canes may be used
- 5 Hard hats to the approved BSI standard must be worn and correctly fasted at all times whilst mounted
- 6 Any exhibit considered not to be under adequate control will be asked to leave the ring
- 7 Animals must be 4 years old or over
- 8 Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday on the day of the show
- 9 Section A, B and Part Bred stallions 13.2h and under – riders must have attained their 12th birthday on the 1 January in the current year
- 10 Section C, D and Part Bred stallions 13.2h and over – riders must have attained their 14th birthday on the 1 January in the current year

- 11 Lead rein ponies must be shown in a snaffle bridle only, with the lead rein attached to the noseband
- 12 First ridden ponies may be shown in any suitable bridle
- 13 **Snaffle bridles only in novice classes**
- 14 Prize money as stated in the schedule
- 15 The judge's decision is final

All medals awarded in accordance with the WPCS rules.
